




Apologetic Approaches: A Study (Paperback)

The objective is not to favor any single approach to apologetics but to better enable the reader to understand where particular apologists stand, where to possibly categorize various apologetic arguments, and be better equipped to make up one s own mind as to which approach is most favorable.
