




Dangerous Kids: Boys Town Approach for Helping Caregivers Treat Aggressive and Violent Youth (Paperback)

For example, Child Behavior Checklist scores tracking behavioral and emotional problems including aggression fall dramatically from admission to departure, and aggressive incidents decrease.
