These plays are also called, 1689 or tragi-comedy; and both these and the titles of some pieces 1690 and fragments handed down to us show that they were burlesques of tragical subjects. 1691 It may, however, be easily supposed that Rhinthon pg 369 did not lose sight of the Athenian tragedy, and it is possible that his two Iphigenias in particular, at Aulis and Tauris, contained many parodies of the two plays of Euripides. I should conceive, however, that he adhered generally to the form of the ancient phlyaces; thus for example, he faithfully imitated the dialect of Tarentum; 1692 we may also be assured that he polished the native farces, so as to fit them for theatrical representation. These pieces were generally written in trimeter iambics, which Rhinthon, however, framed somewhat carelessly,...
